Students become familiar with stories from diverse cultures throughout Africa as they explore their creativity and expand language, cooperative learning and communication skills.

The presentation also includes free access to **Storyvalues**, Cheryl's online storytelling resource, where students are challenged to take *The Storyteller's Journey*, exploring folktales, art and music through videos, games and puzzles.

The digital program is a great way for schools and families to strengthen literacy by learning and sharing stories from around the world.
